

Churchill Mining Sends 'Love Letter' to Government on East Kutai Coal Dispute

Theindonesiatoday.com - [Churchill Mining](#) Plc has filed up to ten-pages of letters to Indonesian Government seeking cooperation to achieve resolution to the East Kutai Coal Project dispute.

The letters are intended to President SBY, East Kutai Regent Isran Noor, Minister of Energy & Mineral Resources Jero Wacik, Minister of Forestry Zulkifli Hasan, Minister of Foreign Affairs Marty Natalegawa, and the Investment Coordinating Board (BKPM).

On the letters, which also include up to 62 attachments, the company said Indonesian Government has violated the treaty between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Republic of Indonesia for the Promotion and Protection of Investments signed on 27 April 1976 and entered into force on 24 March 1977 (UK-Indonesia BIT).
